

Tintico Coffee Ethical Sourcing & Modern Slavery Statement

At Tintico Coffee, we are deeply committed to the ethical sourcing of our coffee beans, ensuring that the farmers who cultivate these precious beans are always treated with dignity and respect. Our core principle is to support direct trade, where fair compensation is provided to the farmers, empowering them to lead sustainable livelihoods and maintain control over their work.

We mainly source our green coffee from South and Central America as well as Africa through a green coffee import partner, who has been selected primarily because they share our values and follow a direct trade-only model, guaranteeing that the coffee is procured without ever resorting to the stock market where prices are fixed by bankers and not based on quality and hard work. As well as providing harvest training, price risk management, market access and logistics to farmers our partners at source support many initiatives to support the communities that produce our coffee. Some examples include:
